Position Summary:

Primary responsibility to prepare and lead the musical portions of all adult worship venues with excellent vocal and instrumental performance. Work in cooperation with the Worship Pastor and Teaching Pastor(s), to recruit, develop, schedule and lead worship teams. Available to serve as needed in an additional area of ministry, according to their specific skill set and experience.

Position Responsibilities:

Musical Leadership

- Demonstrate excellent vocal & instrumental leadership from our worship platforms, including verbal sharing
- Responsible for scheduling musicians for all adult worship venues
- Works with Worship Pastor and teaching pastors to design set flows that gives the church family an
 opportunity to respond to who God is and align with our worship DNA and the week's particular theme
- Primary responsibility for recruiting musicians and coordinating auditions & follow-up
- Continually develop musicians in their chemistry and craft for effectiveness in worship ministry
- Help build a culture where the worship team is a "family" of musicians/creatives on mission through digital communication and team-building activities
- Ensures musicians are properly resourced for effective rehearsals and service execution
- Effectively leads/supervises adult music rehearsals where the musical sound and platform engagement reflects the vision of the worship ministry
- Available to provide music for funerals, weddings and other special events as needed

Technical Worship Production

- Assists in managing and setting patches and loops necessary for quality worship production
- Assists in projected lyrics and chords
- Works with audio engineers to ensure mix reflects the vision of the worship ministry
